Extracts from the Articles of Association detailing qualifications required for Membership

- 2.2** Every Professional member shall be more than 21 years of age. Persons shall be eligible for election as Professional members by first having met one of the qualification requirements in 2.9, and then having completed 2 years full time practical experience in an approved employment, or an equivalent period in an approved part-time employment.
- 2.2.1** Every Associate Member shall be more than 21 years of age. Persons shall be eligible for election as Associate members by first having met one of the qualification requirements in 2.9.1, and then having completed 2 years full time practical experience in an approved employment, or an equivalent period in an approved part-time employment.
- 2.2.2** Every Technical Member shall be more than 21 years of age. No person shall be eligible for election as a Technical Member without first having met the examination or qualification requirements as laid down in Article 2.9.2 and having completed 2 years full time practical experience in an approved employment or an equivalent period in an approved part-time employment.
- 2.4** A Professional member of more than 30 years of age with a Masters degree in any of the listed disciplines may be elected a Fellow at the discretion of council as a mark of distinction for outstanding service to the Institution or to the surveying profession.
- 2.5** A Student shall be a person pursuing an approved fulltime course in a listed discipline at a recognised University or College of higher education.
- 2.9** The following qualifications shall be deemed acceptable with regard to clause 2.2 above.
 - 1. A B.Sc. degree in Geomatics from the Dublin Institute of Technology
 - 2. The final examinations of the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors in the Geomatics Faculty (previously known as the Land and Hydrographic Division)
 - 4. A degree awarded by a recognised University or College of higher education following successful completion of a full-time course of not less than four years duration in any of the listed disciplines.
 - 5. Through experience, service to the profession and demonstrated ability, the council may approve the promotion of an Associate or a Technologist to Professional Membership, or approve the direct election of other suitably qualified persons.
- 2.9.1** The following qualifications shall be deemed acceptable with regard to clause 2.2.1 above.
 - 1. A certificate (2 years), diploma (3 years) or bachelors degree (4 years) issued by a recognised University or College of higher education following the successful completion of a full-time course or its part-time equivalent in a discipline closely related to any of the listed disciplines.
 - 2. Full membership of the Society of Surveying Technicians (UK), in either of the divisions of Land, Hydrographic, or Mineral surveying.
 - 3. RICS part 1 & 2 examinations in either of the divisions of Land, Hydrographic, or Mineral surveying.
 - 4. A certificate issued by a recognised College or Institution following a two year course in any of the listed disciplines.
 - 5. 10 years service in an approved surveying employment
- 2.9.2** The following qualifications shall be deemed acceptable with regard to clause 2.2.2 above.
 - 1. A Certificate (2 years) in Geo-Surveying from the Dublin Institute of Technology.
 - 2. The NCEA Certificate in Geo-Surveying from the Dublin Institute of Technology.
 - 3. Parts 1 and 2 examinations of the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors in the Geomatics Faculty (previously known as the Land and Hydrographic Division).
 - 4. A certificate (2 years) issued by a recognised third level College or Institution following the successful completion of a full-time course or its part-time equivalent in any of the listed disciplines.

Listed Disciplines include Land Surveying, Engineering Surveying, Mine Surveying, Photogrammetry, Geodetic Surveying, Cadastral Surveying, Cartography, Hydrographic Surveying, Remote Sensing, and Land and Geographic Information Systems Management.
 All Associates and Technical Members who apply for transfer to Professional Membership will be required to present themselves for Professional Interview. The Regulations for the Professional Interview are available on the website at www.irish-surveyors.ie
